Now I know something more about the secret of his successful contesting. Karl is using a special program for logging!!!






The next picture shows the tremendous activity from DL6NAA at the 3cm station. I am afraid in this contest I will be not the winner!



As I was not participating in the contest I had much time to make some experiments. The next pictures are showing the noise- floor from DH0F on 144MHz. Left picture shows the situation when they switched on their Transmitter, the right on shows the same when they switched off!



Next both pictures are showing the signal from DL0GTH. Note that their signal is even some dB stronger but the noise- floor is nearly 30dB less! I know that my homemade transverter is not perfect, but the comparison between both signals with nearly the same signal- strength shows that the noise- floor on the spectrum- display from my IC7700 is not produced by my own local oscillator.



The next picture shows the normal situation during contest here in our region. The signal at the centre of the display comes from the famous station from JN59OP which belongs to DK1FG. He is strong indeed but he has also a clean signal. It is nice to see also the weaker signals +- 250KHz!



Last picture shows you that we nearly have no snow anymore.
