



We had a wonderful weather. Not too hot or cold, and above all dry. Unfortunately, we could use the good tropo conditions UK with one exception: On Saturday evening three QSOs to Scotland were possible. The duct was very selective, and nothing was audible at the beginning. But at the end Allan GM4ZUK/p produced a loud signal.

DAOFF on the Wasserkuppe (JO40FF) was QRV again. But thanks to good equipment, additional filtering and a large frequency spacing between us, interference like phase noise on our running frequencies was almost inaudible. But we had often strong QRM directly on our running frequency (144.3535 MHZ for most of the time) by other stations.


Eberhard DG7NCY set up his new station for QO-100, and made a few QSOs.
