Background:

It was decided in Vienna 2010 Meeting to introduce within the 50 MHz Band Plan

- 50,230 MHz as Meteor Scatter (MGM) calling frequency
- 50, 210 – 50,250 MHz as Meteor Scatter (MGM) segment.

In view of the up coming 24th Solar Cycle and hopefully intercontinental DX possibilities, a MGM calling frequency for IONO Scatter and F2 DX should be introduced.

Proposal:

To rename 50,210 – 50,250 MHz into Meteor Scatter/IONO/ F2 Scatter DX Segment and introduce 50,240 MHz as IONO/F2 DX Scatter calling frequency.

Remark:

For the time being, an international DX MGM calling frequency does not exist. Only for the Meteor Scatter users, this segment is proposed.

Due to the different common MGM modes and different interests of the Radio Amateurs, a conflict through the introduction of an international DX calling frequency could be avoided.
