Adding a footnote in chapter 2.1 of the VHF Handbook

Introduction

Some misunderstandings have arisen in the interpretation of the band plan for some digital modes which are machine generated, e.g. for WSPR beacons.

Background

Some frequency lists of WSPR beacons show the dial frequency for USB transmission, others the resulting transmitted frequencies.

Key points and proposal

To prevent any misunderstanding a short footnote should be added in chapter 2.1 for WSPR mode transmissions and in band plans (like a note in HF band plans).

Recommendation

It is recommended to add a footnote for WSPR transmissions in chapter 2.1 of the VHF Handbook and in the band plans:

The frequencies in the band plan are understood as “transmitted frequencies” (not those of the suppressed carrier, respectively not of the VFO dial setting).
