**a. Introduction:**

This paper proposes a special web server where each national contest manager will send the contest logs from his country for evaluation process.

**b. Background:**

Thanks Andy SP7NJX this web server already exists. Many national contest managers upload their logs to this server after each contest. They can also download logs from other countries. National evaluation of the contests is much more accurate now.

**c. Key points and proposal:**

This paper proposes to include two sentences to the Procedure for organising IARU Region 1 contests (VHF Managers Handbook, item 4.2):

*Not later than the third Sunday after the contest the national VHF Manager or properly nominated Contest Committee shall upload to the special web server one copy of each entry in EDI format. National VHF Manager or properly nominated Contest Committee can download other entries from this web server in order to make more accurate national evaluation.*

**d. Recommendation:**

National VHF Managers or properly nominated Contest Committees should send the electronic contest log data entries from IARU R1 contests to a special web page to allow an exchange of logs for more accurate national evaluation.
